LODGING

The hotel also offers room service, high-speed Internet access, valet laundry service, a concierge, a gift shop, complimentary airport shuttle service, and two parking options available: self-park for \$11/day and valet for \$24/day. All rooms feature two two-line telephones, work areas, and refreshment centers.

AIR TRAVEL

O'Hare International Airport (ORD) is the most convenient airport to the Doubletree Hotel Chicago O'Hare Airport-Rosemont. The hotel offers a complimentary shuttle from the O'Hare airport to the hotel. Chicago Midway Airport (MDW) also services Chicago.
