Catholic Network of Volunteer Service (CNVS), established in 1963, is a non-profit membership organization of nearly 200 domestic and international volunteer and lay mission programs. Currently, more than 12,000 volunteers and lay missionaries serve in these programs throughout the U.S. and in 112 other countries.

CNVS publishes and distributes RESPONSE, the most comprehensive handbook of lay mission volunteer opportunities. RESPONSE is distributed free of charge to persons interested in faith-based service and those who promote such service. We also provide our member programs with recruitment services, training and technical assistance resources including our National Conference, Formation Workshops, Renewal Workshops, and our web based Resource Library.

CNVS also administers the AmeriCorps Education Awards program (AEAP) for our member programs. The program is funded by the Corporation for National Service and is a network of faith based programs which serves people in the areas of public safety, basic human needs, education, and the environment, with a special emphasis on working with youth and the poor. CNVS/AEAP is part of the national service movement currently engaging Americans of all ages and backgrounds in service to address our Nation's most critical problems.

The 2009 CNVS National Conference will be held November 12-15, 2009 at the Durham Marriott Convention Center in Durham, North Carolina. Each year, staff of faith-based volunteer programs gather to learn new skills, share their experiences, and network with colleagues. The conference features a series of keynote speakers as well as a variety of workshops on all aspects of program management and development.

This year's conference theme is "Called to Community." Throughout the conference, we plan to examine different communities in which program staff and volunteers live and work. We will focus on intentional, virtual, and global communities.

Approximately 125 staff persons from CNVS member programs from across the United States attend the CNVS National Conference. They are Catholics and Christians committed to living out faith in service to others. Nearly 60% of the volunteers who serve in CNVS member programs are between the ages of 19-35.

A vibrant, diverse town, Durham is the perfect location for conference participants to be inspired to welcome people of all races and backgrounds into their volunteer and professional communities.

The Durham Marriott Convention Center is located in downtown Durham, 20 miles from Raleigh Durham Airport (RDU), and within walking distance of dozens of neighborhood attractions.
